## The following parameters are in place for this contest:

- 1. Your song must be original and performed by you.
- 2. You may have one person accompany you.
- 3. All music genres are welcome.
- 4. 1 song only @ 5 minutes or less.
- 5. There will be two age categories: 13-18 years of age (\$500 prize) & 12 years of age and under (\$300 prize). Each category will have an honorable mention. Prizes are sponsored by Songbird Orchids.
- 6. Top 5 contestants (and immediate family) get into MeadowGrass free on May 24th, we'll announce the winners at 10:30am and winners will perform around 11:15 am.
- 7. All submissions will be anonymous to the judges; each judge will receive copies of the recordings without personal identifying information.
- 8. Judges will receive a scoring sheet for use in evaluating. Your song will be judged on the following categories: melody, lyrics, originality, and overall effect.
- 9. The questions below must be answered and submitted with your song. These questions will not be included in the judges evaluation; they are for organizational purposes only.
